## Team History

To allow skaters to train and compete at the highest level of Aussie Skate Synchronized Skating, our Ice Delight team was formed in late 2006.

When the Aussie Skate Sync Program was extended to 4 Levels, our Ice Delight team moved up to become our Aussie Skate Division 4 team from 2009.

Since 2006 Ice Delight have won numerous medals in Aussie Skate competitions and have performed very well in our Exhibition skates.

**Our club's goal** - is to offer the benefits of Synchronized Skating and Theatre on Ice to as many skaters as possible.

These benefits include - fun, friendships, team spirit, challenge, fitness, new skills, performance opportunities, local, national and international competition opportunities.

**Ice Delight** enables skaters to learn the basics of Synchronized Skating & Theatre on Ice while having fun and making new friends.

## Goals for Ice Delight include –



- Share friendships with other children with the same love of ice skating.
- Develop team members' confidence while learning new skills.
- To develop team members Synchronized Skating skills, which will give them a head start when they move up to a State or National level team.
- To double team selected Novice age team members with the Ice Dazzle team during their transition to State Level, to fast track their progress and to build their confidence by additional training and competition experience, this will assist them to gain selection to skate in the Ice Dazzle competition program line-up.
- Skaters selected to double team Ice Delight & Ice Dazzle but unable to do so during their transition to State level, may require longer in Ice Delight before moving up to Ice Dazzle, as they will not have the advantages that double teaming provides.
- Form Aussie Skate Synchronized Skating Division 4 mini team/s of 6-12 skaters and prepare the team/s to compete in the Aussie Skate competitions. These events provide our skaters with valuable competition experience, before they progress to competing with higher level State or National Level teams. Our skaters also greatly enjoy competing together.
- Ice Delight training in Term 2 will focus on learning Theatre on Ice, which gives skaters another opportunity to participate and encourages them to develop and express their artistic side. Skaters enjoy creating stories and developing themes on the ice.
- Ice Delight, under the age of 18 as at the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020, will be offered the opportunity to perform and compete in our **Ice Stars** Novice Theatre on Ice teams. Membership of Ice Skating Queensland is required to compete in Theatre on Ice competitions.
- To prepare the team for Exhibitions and Displays. Our Club is proud to hold an Ice Spectacular Exhibition Skate each year. Ice Delight will perform in this annual event in both their Ice Delight Synchronized Skating mini team, and in an Ice Stars Novice Theatre on Ice team.

## Requirements to join –

- **Age:** from 7 years of age as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 20, or by selection
- **Aussie Skate Level:** for skaters in classes Free Skate or Dance Level 3 & 4 & higher, or by selection
- **Individual Training:** Synchronized Skaters need to be training in Skate School, Private, Shared or Group lessons to gain higher Individual Skating Skills and the tests needed to move up to State or National level teams.
- **Individual Skills for Synchronized Skaters:** In 2020 we will be commencing a new development program for our State & National level teams & squads. See your Sync coach if you would like an Ice Dazzle or Ice Vivacity Individual Skills achievement card (depending on your child's age), to enable them to start getting their coach to sign off in their Private, Shared or Group lessons, the Individual skills as they achieve them. This will give them a head start when they move up to one of these teams.
